How the Review came about

Mental Health Strategy: 2017-2027



- Recommendation from the 10-year Mental Health Strategy.
- Scottish Parliament's Education and Skills Committee report on how PSE is taught in Scotland – also recommended a review.

Overview

The Review was undertaken in three phases:

- Phase 1: review of communications and initial exploration of current teaching resources;
- Phase 2: thematic inspection of 55 schools and early learning centres led by Education Scotland. Venues were carefully selected to ensure a wide geographic/size/ deprivation spread; and,
- * **Phase 3:** considered the findings of Phase 2 and included engagement with COSLA, local authorities and Third Sector organisations to refine the final recommendations.



Key findings of the Review

Review of Personal and Social Education

Preparing Scotland's Children and Young People for learning, work and life



 Published during an debate in the Scottish Parliament on 23 January 2019, the report of the PSE Review detailed key findings and made 16 recommendations.



Implementation

- * There are five key themes implementation of the recommendations will focus on:
 - * Teaching resources;
 - Initial Teacher Education and Career Long Professional Learning;
 - * Pupil Engagement;
 - * Third Sector; and,
 - * Service Support.



Implementation

- * An Implementation Plan is nearing completion.
- * Convene Implementation and Delivery Group, led by a partnership of the Scottish Government and COSLA.
- * PSE Lead Officer Network is underway.
- The remaining recommendations will be combined and taken forward by Sub Groups.
- * Delivery of the recommendations expected by March 2021.



Implementation

CRITICAL

Engagement with and empowerment of children and young people in design and delivery of PSE.





Progress to date...

- Review of the Conduct of Relationships, Sexual Health and Parenthood Education in Schools teaching guidance is underway.
- * Engaging with colleagues across Government to align policy areas and ensure consistent messaging.
- * Collating good practice from across Scotland.



Progress to date...

- PSE Lead Officers Network has met on four occasions since the announcement.
- Considered how to tackle sexual harassment at their first meeting.
- * They have since convened five Sub Groups:
 - * Resource Hub/Toolkit
 - * Monitoring and Tracking
 - * Qualification in PSE
 - * Raising the profile of PSE
 - * Sexual Harassment
- National event in March 2020.
